

## Connecting Across Topics (CAT) Communities: Fall 2010

CAT Communities are designed around student interests, and they offer mentoring from both a professor and an advanced undergraduate Learning Assistant who has been successful in the same classes. Students will be enrolled in two general education courses and one connections course together. Once a week, students will meet in the connections course to discuss connections between the two general education classes and apply what they have been learning. Space is limited as each CAT community only has 22 seats available. Each student should only sign up for one CAT community. Students should not sign up if they already have college credit for one or both of the main classes in the CAT community.
