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## INTRODUCTION

In 1947, Alexander Feinland then professor at the National Conservatory of Music and Declamation in Panama, Republic of Panama, published a book titled The Combination of Violin and Violoncello Without Accompaniment with an introduction by Dr. Paul A. Pisk, professor of Music at the University of Redlands. This book strived to list as completely as possible all of the music for this particular combination which could be found. The author, however, realizing that many other duos than he listed exist, appealed to composers, musicologists, and music lovers to supplement this list. Since it was the writer's good fortune to be closely associated with the author, he has resolved to expand the list as far as he can.

Because the listing of duos in the newest source-book, String Music in Print, by Margaret Farrish, is far from complete means had to be found to unearth music of this type. Knowing that assembling an exhaustive list is impossible, but nevertheless wishing to explore all available sources, letters were sent to directors of important European conservatories, music publishers in the United States and Europe, and musicians whom the writer knows to be active in string playing and teaching.

Response was far from complete. Many of the conservatory libraries were unable to supply the information requested because of lack of time on part of their staff members. It is likely that much material could be uncovered by direct

examination of their collections. Neither was the response from publishers as complete as was expected. This seems to imply that those who failed to answer do not publish duos of this kind. The best response was from other musicians; their contributions are significant.

For the convenience of teachers and performers, an attempt is made to grade all the works which are available. These are not pieces for beginners; players must have reasonable technical command of their instrument. With this in mind, difficulty is indicated by Roman numerals, (I), specifying the least difficult, (II), moderately difficult, and (III), those demanding considerable virtuosity.

#### SOURCES OF INFORMATION

To date, the most complete list of Duos is in the book, The Combination of Violin and Violoncello Without Accompaniment by Alexander Feinland, mentioned above. This book was written in 1944. A second edition was published in 1947. In this book, Professor Feinland had built his lists largely through correspondence with libraries and musicians interested in this facet of literature.

Regardless of the length of the lists he was able to compile, Feinland was never satisfied with the response his inquiries had received. He projected a third edition which was never finished. Six hundred-ten items are found in this work.

As a source, the book, String Music in Print by Margaret Farrish, excludes works in manuscript. Nor are all duos in print listed. This list is probably limited to works being currently published. Of the 118 items listed, 74 are already listed in Feinland; this leaves only 54 new items.

Altogether then, only 664 items are available in these two standard reference works. However, the investigation carried on by this study increased the list to a total of 987 items, an increase of 323 items. The sources leading to the discovery of these additional items are listed in the Appendix.

#### CONCLUSION

This study has located additional duos and has increased the number of items to the existing lists by approximately 49 percent. There is much more work to be done, for, undoubtedly, the examination of European libraries would yield many more items.

In grading those works available, the writer realizes the restriction which is automatically placed on this study because of the inaccessibility of so large a body of material. Nevertheless, he believes that by grading accessable material, he added value to this study.

## INTRODUCTION

In 1947, Alexander Feinland then professor at the National Conservatory of Music and Declamation in Panama, Republic of Panama, published a book titled The Combination of Violin and Violoncello Without Accompaniment with an introduction by Dr. Paul A. Pisk, professor of Music at the University of Redlands. This book strived to list as completely as possible all of the music for this particular combination which could be found. The author, however, realizing that many other duos than he listed exist, appealed to composers, musicologists, and music lovers to supplement this list. Since it was the writer's good fortune to be closely associated with the author, he has resolved to expand the list as far as he can.

Because the listing of duos in the newest source-book, String Music in Print, by Margaret Farrish, is far from complete means had to be found to unearth music of this type. Knowing that assembling an exhaustive list is impossible, but nevertheless wishing to explore all available sources, letters were sent to directors of important European conservatories, music publishers in the United States and Europe, and musicians whom the writer knows to be active in string playing and teaching.

Response was far from complete. Many of the conservatory libraries were unable to supply the information requested because of lack of time on part of their staff members. It is likely that much material could be uncovered by direct examination of their collections. Neither was the response from

publishers as complete as was expected. This seems to imply that those who failed to answer do not publish duos of this kind. The best response was from other musicians; their contributions are significant.

For the convenience of teachers and performers, an attempt is made to grade all the works which are available. These are not pieces for beginners; players must have reasonable technical command of their instrument. With this in mind, difficulty is indicated by Roman numerals, (I), specifying the least difficult, (II), moderately difficult, and (III), those demanding considerable virtuosity.

#### SOURCES OF INFORMATION

To date, the most complete list of Duos is in the book, The Combination of Violin and Violoncello Without Accompaniment by Alexander Feinland, mentioned above. This book was written in 1944. A second edition was published in 1947. In this book, Professor Feinland had built his lists largely through correspondence with libraries and musicians interested in this facet of literature.

Regardless of the length of the lists he was able to compile, Feinland was never satisfied with the response his inquiries had received. He projected a third edition which was never finished. Six hundred-ten items are found in this work.

As a source, the book, String Music in Print by Margaret Farrish, excludes works in manuscript. Nor are all duos in print

listed. This list is probably limited to works being currently published. Of the 118 items listed, 74 are already listed in Feinland; this leaves only 54 new items.

Altogether then, only 664 items are available in these two standard reference works. However, the investigation carried on by this study increased the list to a total of 987 items, an increase of 323 items. The sources leading to the discovery of these additional items are listed in the Appendix.

## CONCLUSION

This study has located additional duos and has increased the number of items to the existing lists by approximately 49 percent. There is much more work to be done, for, undoubtedly, the examination of European libraries would yield many more items.

In grading those works available, the writer realizes the restriction which is automatically placed on this study because of the inaccessability of so large a body of material. Nevertheless, he believes that by grading accessable material, he added value to this study.
