

To Run the Kid Chef Multimedia Program

System Requirements:

- Pentium 200 Mhz processor or higher
- Microsoft® Windows® 98, Windows 98 Second Edition, Windows Millennium Edition, Windows 2000 Professional Service Pack 3, Windows XP, Windows XP Home Edition
- 64 Mb RAM
- 4x or faster CD-ROM drive
- Sound card with speakers
- Screen resolution of 640x480, 800x600, or 1024x768 (best)

To run the Kid Chef program, you will need to download files to your computer. Follow these steps:

1. Within DSpace, click on the **View/Open** link for the file “kidchef.zip.”
2. If you are prompted to open or save the file, select **Save**. Save it to an empty folder on your computer. The file is 354 Mb, so it will take some time to download.
3. To extract or “unzip” the files, you will need WinZip or other file compression software compatible with the WinZip format. You can buy WinZip or download a trial version from www.winzip.com. Follow instructions from WinZip to install the software and unzip the files. Create a new folder, “kidchef,” in which to unzip the file.
4. After the file is unzipped, display the contents of the kidchef folder using My Computer or Windows Explorer. Double click on this file:

5. An Open dialog box will appear. Select the “Kid_Chef.tbk” file and click **Open**. The program will begin.
