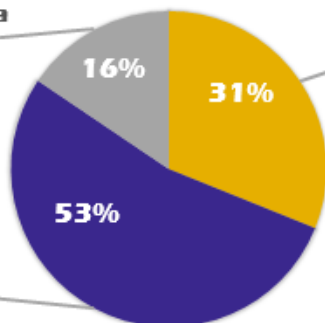

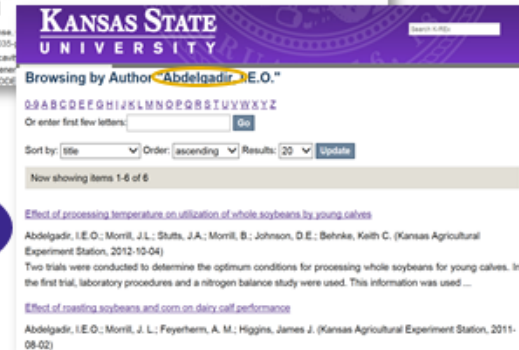
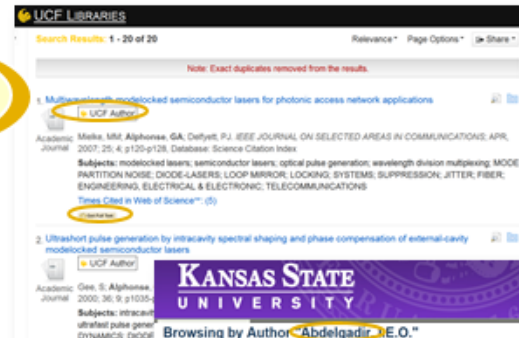
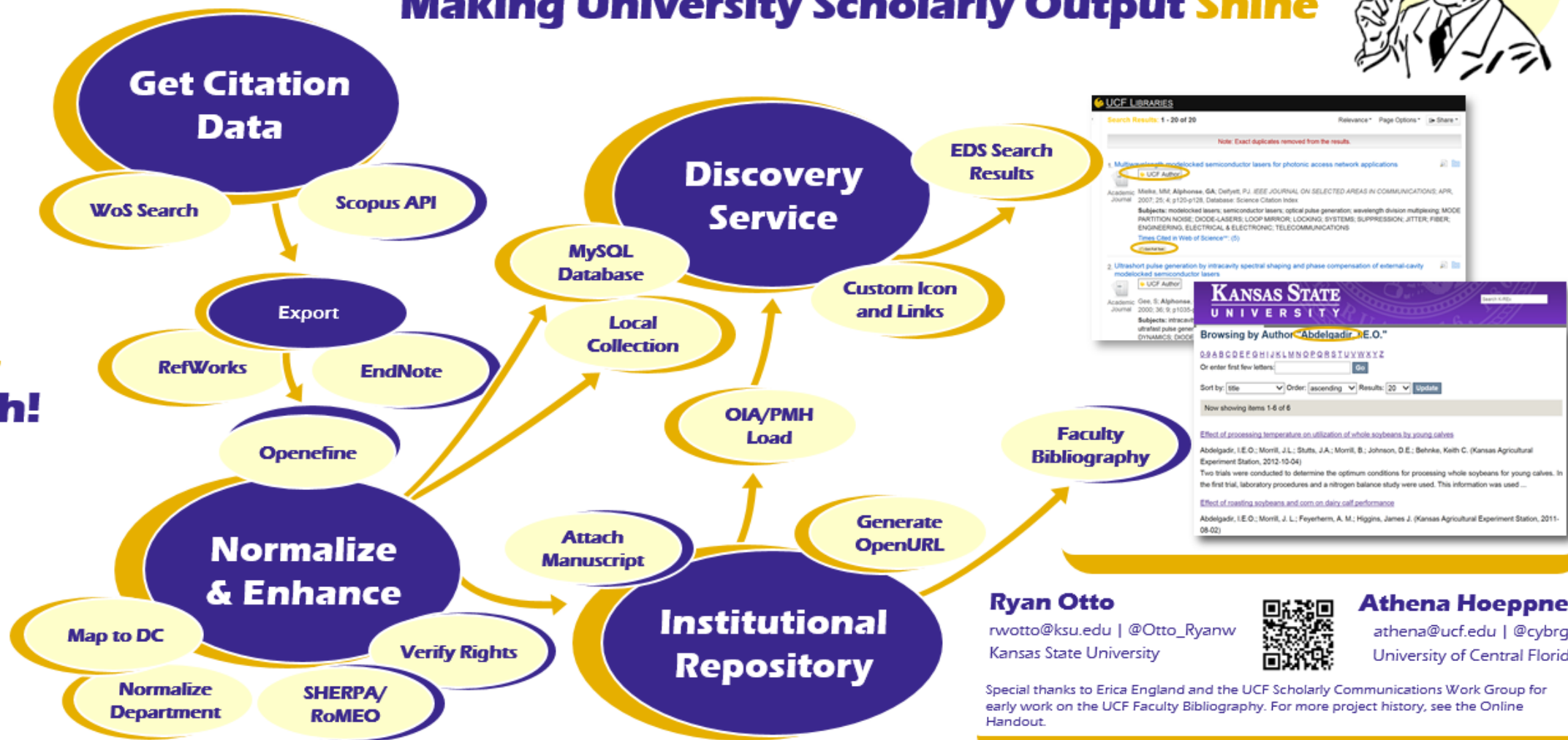
Showcase Your Research!

Institutional Repository

- Single source for full bibliography, whether manuscript is hosted on IR or on publisher site
- RSS feeds integrates bibliography into faculty and department web pages
- Social Scholarly network link to IR for durable and consistent URLs

EBSCO Discovery Service

- University icon next to records from databases
- Discoverable in the most-used search interface
- Links to publisher hosted full text via OpenURL



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
