First day of new key signatures (4 flats and 4 sharps)

Step one: Identify the starting pitch of the major scale with four flats in the key signature.

Step two: Write down the letter names of the major scale in order.

Step three: Identify the flats.

Step four: Identify the starting pitch of the relative natural minor scale.

Step five: Write down the letter names of the relative minor scale in order.

Step five: Identify the scale degree and note name to be changed to create a harmonic minor scale.

Step six: Write down the modification.

Step seven: Identify the scale degrees and notes to be changed to create a melodic minor scale.

Step eight: Write down the modification.

Step nine: Repeat step one through eight for the key signature with four sharps.
