The number would be still larger but some have not been admitted on account of not being up to the Standard of qualification in scholarship.

The age of more than three fourths of the Students is 15 years and over.

More than sixteen counties are represented in the Institution.

Fourteen are now in the Commercial Department and this department promises all that could be expected.

The number of daily recitations averages thirty.

Fifteen of the Students have been in the army, and three died in the service,

Plans are being devised and we trust will be made practicable so that the children of Soldiers and their Widows desiring it can be educated here at the very lowest expense possible.

More than thirty connected with the Institution are now and have been Teachers in the State, one at least is County Superintendent and Teacher.
